Overview

The 7th Cupa Crater XCO is an UCI Class2 Elite Men and Men Junior MountainBike Cross-Country Olympic event scheduled for the 6th of July 2019.

Location

GPS: Lati 46.98045730789811 Longi 22.02166557312012

Betfia and Baile 1 Mai Resort Forest, Bihor, Romania, 10 km from Oradea (DE-Großwardein, HU-Nagyvarad) an important city in Western Romania, 25 km from the Hungarian border, 180 km from the Ukrainian border and 250 km from the Serbian border.

Acces

For easy acces with the car, follow this route: Oradea – Sinmartin (acces throug the european road E79 – national road DN76) – Baile 1 Mai – Betfia.

Event rules

The race is conducted based on the UCI regulations for Mountain Bike Races. Valid UCI international licenses are required for the Elite Men race. Holders of UCI international licenses that do not bear a photograph will be required to present an approved and valid government photo ID in addition to their UCI license. Hobby licensed and Amateur riders will participate in a separate race, on their own responsibility.

Categories

- UCI Elite Men
- UCI Elite Men Junior
- Hobby licensed Men, Hobby licensed Women with different age categories
- Amateurs without licenses
- Child Races with different age categories

Racing age: a rider's racing age for all categories is determined by 2019 minus the riders year of birth.

Registration

- Registrations for this race are open to Elite Men and Elite Men Junior riders (with UCI license) and also for licensed Hobby and Amateur riders, which will be made on their own responsibility (with parental approval for riders under 18 years).
- Pre-registrations can be made online 06 Mai 2019 – 03 July 2019, filling the form online at <https://www.velosportoradea.ro/cupa-crater-xco/>
- Online registration closes in 3 July, 24:00 PM (Romanian Time).
- Registration can be also made on the race venue according to the schedule posted, by filling in the form.
- Validation will be done on race venue, after the payment of the registration fee.
- Registration validation for Hobby riders under the age of 18 will be done only if a parent/legal guardian is present or by presenting a written accord from the parent authenticated by a public notary.

Fees

- between 06 Mai – 28 June: 100 lei for the UCI Elite Race, 60 Lei for the Hobby and Amateur, 40 Lei for the Child and Family Races;

- between 29 June – 2 July: 110 lei for the UCI Elite Race, 70 Lei for the Amateur Races, 45 Lei for the Child and Family Races;
- at the Race Venue: 120 lei for the UCI Elite Race, 80 Lei for the Amateur Races, 50 Lei for the Child and Family Races.

17-21 – XCO and XCM Course open for practice (helmet and race numbers are obligatory).

21 – Team managers/riders meeting – at the „Caii din Vale” horse complex (the Start/Finish area for Crater Maraton UCI C3 event, GPS 46°57'57.2"N 22°01'24.9"E)

06 July 2019, Saturday:

08:00 - 10 – Registration at the event;

09:30 - 10:15 – Childrens Race

10.30 – Start Hobby Race;

11.45 – Briefing and call up for the UCI Elite Race;

12:00 – Start UCI Elite Men and UCI Elite Men Junior Race;

14:30 – Awards Ceremony – at the „Caii din Vale” horse complex (the Start/Finish area for the Crater Maraton event GPS 46°57'57.2"N 22°01'24.9"E)

17-19 – Registration at the Crater Maraton UCI C3 event (at Caii din Vale horse complex);

07 July 2019, Sunday:

08:00-17 – Crater Maraton UCI C3 Course.

Event facts

- The UCI category of the event is for the Elite Men and Elite Men Junior categories. A separate Under 23 category is not offered at this race, they will participate in Elite category.
- UCI points are being awarded as per the UCI Regulations for the Elite points scale for the first 10 places in Elite Men and Elite Men Junior categories as follows: 1st–30p, 2nd–20p, 3rd–15p, 4th–12p, 5th–10p, 6th–8p, 7th–6p, 8th–4p, 9th–2p, 10th–1p.
- Prizes being awarded for Elite Men (first 10 riders) and UCI Elite Men Juniors (first 5 riders) at least: 500-400-300-150-100-90-80-70-60-50 Lei and 100-80-70-50-30 Lei.
- Riders in the Elite category must present a current race license, issued by their National Cycling Federation or proof thereof. Registration will not accept entry of non-licensed Elite riders.
- Race numbers are provided at registration and the numbers are allocated by the Secretary Commissaire.
- All race license holders are subject to drug testing to ensure competitions are fair and riders are free from the use of performance enhancing drugs. As a licenced rider, you could be tested at any time.
- Any medical problems should be reported to the Commissaires Panel or to the medical staff.
- An area allocated for riders/managers meeting will be setup on site at the event.
- Changing rooms will be set up in the Start/Finish area.
- Toilets for participants will be set up in the Start/Finish area.
- Bike washing will be set up in the „Caii din Vale” horse complex (the Start/Finish area for the Crater Maraton UCI C3 event)

Race course

The Start/Finish area will be set up in Betfia near the old quarry/mine.

The track's paths are mostly solid, but we have some downhill parts on boulders and gravel free downhill parts (Hopps, MoSS, Wall) and some steep climbing parts with some roots and gravel.

In case of heavy rain or mud the „Peak”, the „MoSS”, and „The Wall” section will not be entirely included in the race course, instead the ”Rain Options” shortcuts will be used.

Race course details

Length: ~ 4,1 km

Elevation: ~ 250 m per lap

Projected Lap Numbers

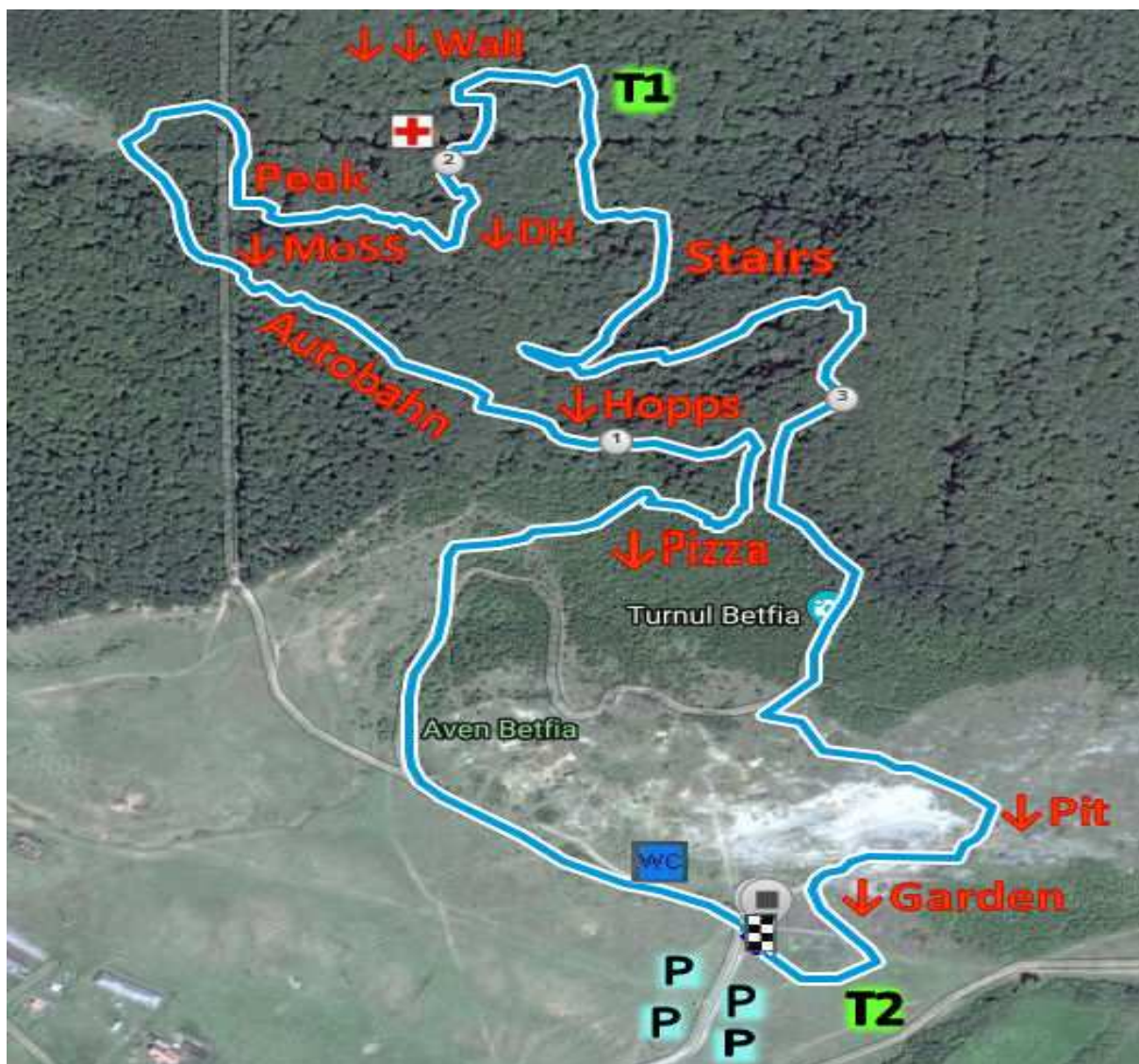
UCI Elite Men: between 6-8 laps

Hobby: ~3 laps

Children: between 1-3 laps on a specially designed track close to the Start/Finish Zone.

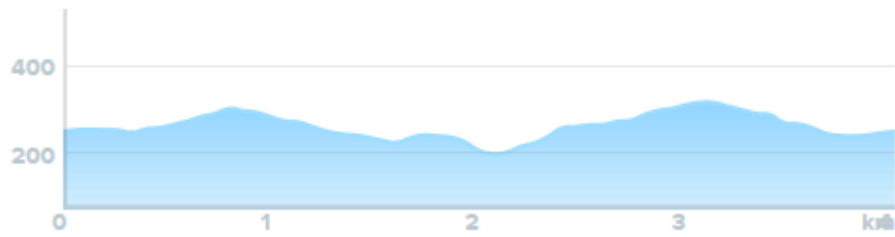
Number of laps may be subject to changes on race day as decided by the PCP.

Map



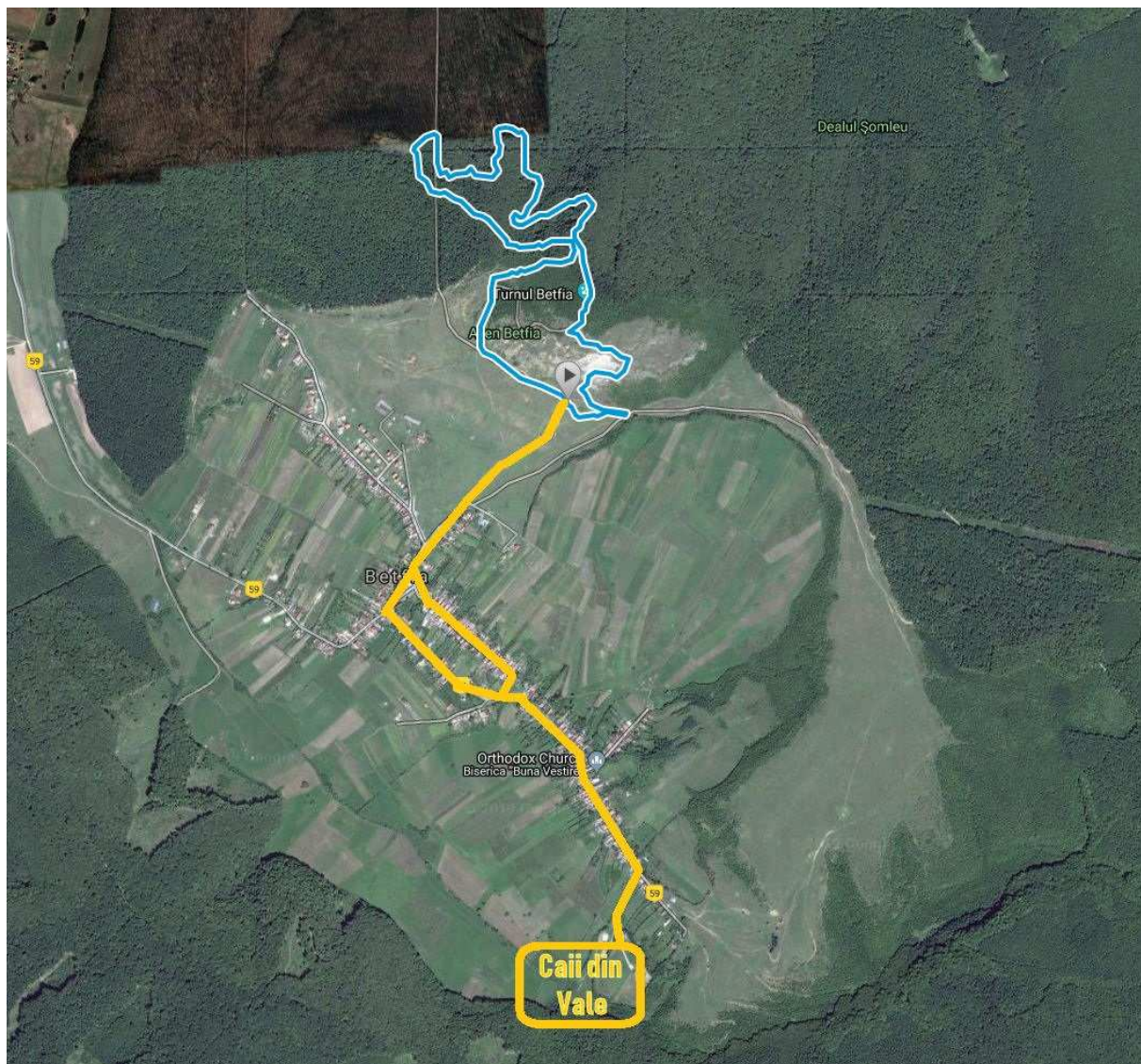
